National Policy Advice to President-Elect Obama

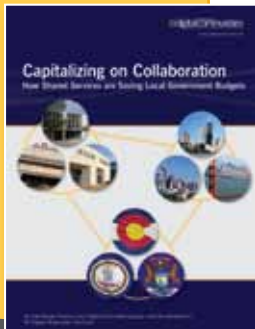

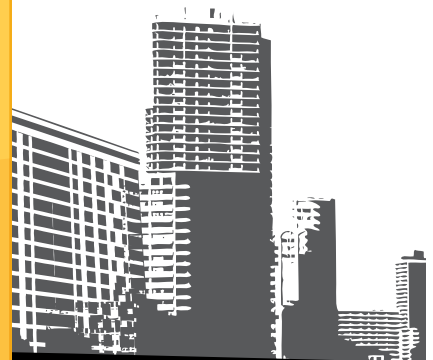
